

Health and Social Care – Year 10

Component One:

Human lifespan development

Focus: students will learn how human development is affected by different factors and that people deal differently with life events.

Key elements:

- Understanding the different life stages
- To examine PIES development across the life stages
- To study the different factors which affect growth and development such as genetics, diet, lifestyle choices, exercise, culture and economic factors

We will then complete assessment one on human lifespan development

Unit length:

12-14 weeks

Component two:

Human lifespan development: How individuals deal with life events

Key elements:

- Students will examine examples of expected and unexpected life events
- They will explore events that can impact on a person's PIES
- They will examine how people react and respond to life events differently and how people adapt to change
- Students will examine different types of support such as family and friends as well as formal support

We will then complete assessment two on how individuals deal with life events

Unit length:

6-8 weeks

Component two: health and social care services and values

Key elements:

- students will explore health and social care services and how they meet the needs of service users
 - Students will examine different health care services and understand the difference between primary, secondary and tertiary care such as GP, specialist medical care, physiotherapy
 - They will examine different social care services and how these meet the needs of service users looking at examples such as youth work, residential care and domiciliary care

We will then complete an assessment on care services

Unit length:

6-8 weeks

Component two: health and social care services and values

Demonstrating care values in practice

Key elements:

- students will examine the barriers that can make it difficult for service users to access services such as physical and sensory barriers, social and cultural barriers or geographical barriers
 - Students will learn about how these barriers can be overcome by either the service users or the provider

We will then complete assessment four on barriers to services
