

Soon Ollie is caught up in their battle: to stop Maddy Sikes destroying the city. Time is


running out for Ollie and his new friends, and millions of lives are at stake ...




dreams? She'll need a miracle of cosmic proportions.


Join 12-year-old Tash and her best friend Sam in a story of adventure, survival and hope, set in the vivid Himalayan landscape of Tibet and India.

And so, with a backpack of Tash's father's mysterious papers and two trusty yaks by their side, their extraordinary journey across the mountains begins.






A captivating animal adventure destined to be loved by readers of all ages.



Years have passed since the love between Sephy - a Cross - and Callum - a Nought destroyed their world and changed their families and society forever.


