Dear Parents/Guardians,

A very warm welcome back to all our students and staff this academic year, I do hope you have all had a lovely Summer break.

It has been such a brilliant first week and great to see so many of our students returning in the full uniform. Please continue to support us and ensure that your son/daughter wears the correct uniform every day because our priority, after such a turbulent 18 months, is to have students back in lessons and learning, as they should be doing, rather than risk missing any more vital learning time.

Can I remind you as parents/guardians of the following:

- School shoes must be black and polishable, with no clear sports branding or logos displayed.
 Trainers are not permitted.
- **Skirts** must be knee length or below the knee.
- **Trousers** must be plain black trousers in slim, standard or comfort fit. Black jeans, jeggings, leggings, jogging bottoms (should not have jean style pockets) are not permitted.
- **Piercings** facial piercings are not permitted and should be removed for the school day. Only one stud per ear.

You will notice that we have introduced a new compulsory student ID lanyard and a red folder that students are to bring with them to school every day. This is to help our students to be even more organised. Over time, we will continue to add vital information and useful subject inserts to the folder. In addition, it contains a copy of their timetable and a homework record diary.

During some lessons this week students have been involved in 'Behaviour Boost' sessions and assemblies, where teachers have been supporting and explaining our new approach in school. Many of our students have earnt rewards for their great participation in these sessions and staff have been hugely impressed with their positive attitudes. This was an essential step to ensure that our new policy is understood by all.
