Food Technology Summer Masterclass – Tuesday 2nd August 2022

We would like to offer a 'Food Technology Summer Masterclass' to incorporate some simple money saving recipes to help families through these difficult times. Food prices are at a premium now and it can be difficult to make the household budget stretch, therefore, we would like to invite households, who might not have the confidence in their skills, to join us at this masterclass to work together to produce some money saving options.

The masterclass will take place on **Tuesday 2nd August, from 10am – 3pm**, with a lunch break in between.

The first half of the day will consist of basic bread skills, with the outcome being a pizza or a tear and share bread loaf. The second half of the day will focus on some basic knife and making skills. We would ideally like to cover a tomato sauce base recipe that can be altered to create a Chilli, Bolognese or Cottage Pie, and a tomato sauce for pizza making.

Recipe ingredients will be provided to create the basic dishes, but you may bring additional ingredients if you wish. You will also need to bring a container to take your dish home.

A booklet will be provided on the day with several additional recipe ideas to try at home.
