

Dear Parents / Guardians,

This academic year we have relaunched homework across the school. Covid has obviously affected education over the past couple of years and homework was not the priority at this time; however, we feel the time is right to reintroduce the importance of homework. We believe homework not only enhances the school curriculum but also develops other skills such as organisation and independent learning.

At the start of the academic year, all students received a red folder and homework diary insert. Students are given time in their lessons to write their homework in their diaries, along with the due date. In the diary there is also a box for students to tick off once they have completed it.

We ask for parents support in checking their child's homework diary. This is a useful link between parents and the school. Please could parents check their child's diary and sign off the previous week. It's your child's responsibility to present the parent with the diary and a pen, as parents are busy people!

Each week, tutors will check their tutees dairies and that parents have signed the previous week. This helps us to check students are using them correctly and support them with their organisation.

Homework club

We also wanted to make you aware that as a school, we offer a homework club every Monday, Tuesday and Thursday during lunch and after-school in E4. If you feel your child would benefit from this, please encourage them to come along. Homework Club takes place in a supervised, quiet atmosphere where students can get their homework done. Students can eat their packed lunch in the room, and I sometimes even get biscuits and squash out too!
