A huge congratulations to ex-student Ben Brooker who will be playing in the SANIX World Rugby Youth Tournament 2023.


Upon leaving John Ferneley, Benjamin enrolled at Brooksby College on the Tigers Rugby programme, studying Sports.

The tournament will be held at the Global Arena in Munakata city, Fukuoka (Japan), between April 26th and May 6th 2023. This tournament focuses on developing, strengthening and promoting the game of rugby. It is also a goal to foster healthy youth development and international cultural exchange through rugby.

PERSONAL DEVELOPMENT UPDATE

As we move into our second term of the academic year, I thought it would be a good idea to send you an year group update on what we are studying in Personal Development lessons:

Key Stage 3

Year 7

Year 7 have had a wonderful time getting to know their teachers and settling into life at John Ferneley. A lot of the activities we have done in lessons so far have centred on friendships. A large part of our Personal Development curriculum looks at the attributes of positive and healthy relationships, and this is the Year 7 introduction to this. This term we will be looking at Online Safety, where we look at students becoming "Internet Citizens".

Year 8

Year 8 started the year continuing from their work last year on Healthy Relationships and looking at their relationship with themselves. We have explored stereotypes, making judgements and how to handle pressures from different areas of their lives. This term students will begin to look at Intimate Relationships.

Year 9

Year 9 have again built on their prior knowledge on Healthy Relationships and have started to look at romantic and physical relationships. Lessons have focused on identifying positive and negative traits in relationships and how to tackle unhealthy behaviours. This term we will look further into consent, but also build on Year 7 and Year 8 work to look at online dangers too. We will be using some real life examples for this, and exploring 'Breck's Last game' and 'Kayleigh's Love Story' – please see further details below:

PERSONAL DEVELOPMENT UPDATE CONTINUED

Key Stage 4

Year 10

Last term, Year 10 continued to look at the Health Relationships, areas they have built on at Key Stage 3 and explored further topics surrounding consent. We looked at the relationship cycle and how relationships may move into different phases as time goes on. We have looked at different types of intimacy and how the media portrays unrealistic expectations on body types, wealth and happiness.

This term, we will move on to Mental Health and Wellbeing. We will continue on from the work started exploring specific Mental Health challenges.

There will be a focus on eating disorders (from end of January onwards). If your child will find these topic area difficult, please contact myself or Mrs Oates for support – we aim to have fully inclusive safe classroom but we do appreciate that this topic may be difficult for some students.



Year 11

Year 11 have been, once again, looking at positive relationships and external dangers. They have explored difficult topics relating to abuse, honour-based violence and unhealthy relationships. They have been exceptionally mature about discussing and dealing with these topics in lessons.

We are going to be spend the first few weeks in January 2023 looking at managing stress and pressures of exam, as well as checking in on College applications. Towards the end of this half term, we will complete their topic on dangers and relationships. Alongside this topic, we would like to show them the documentary 'Abused by my Girlfriend'. This is rated as a "G" for guidance on the BBC and contains some upsetting scenes and strong language (for more information, please follow > https://www.bbc.co.uk/iplayer/episode/p0700912/abused-by-my-girlfriend).
