Dear Parents/Guardians,

<u>Industrial Action planned on Wednesday 1st February 2023 ~ School closed to some year groups</u>

I am writing to update you regarding the industrial action to be taken by members of the NEU (National Education Union) on Wednesday 1st February 2023.

The NEU represent a large proportion of teachers at John Ferneley College. This means we have had to complete a risk assessment to consider the impact on the school of not having a number of staff available to work. The reduced number of teaching staff on site does not allow the school to be open as normal and, therefore, the school will be closed to students in some year groups.

John Ferneley College will be closed on Wednesday 1st February to students in Years 7, 8, 9 and 10.

John Ferneley College will be <u>open</u> on Wednesday 1st February for students in Year 11, who should plan to attend as normal.

The school will also be open to some students who are considered to be vulnerable and to some students whose parents/guardians are critical workers. A separate communication has been sent to the parents/guardians of vulnerable students, to ask them to let us know if they would like to accept their place at school on Wednesday 1st February 2023.
