TUTOR – Maths GCSE online platform

We are excited to inform you that John Ferneley College is partnering with Complete Mathematics to provide 'TUTOR' - an intelligent online tutoring system for your child which will aid them in their GCSE exam preparation.

TUTOR will help your child to review and improve their Maths through a mixture of videos and quizzes and is incredibly easy to use. It is also personalised - using diagnostics that uncover the most appropriate Maths journey for every individual. Your child's teacher will be using the programme analytics to identify student's individual strengths and weaknesses, helping us to support them in the run up to the GCSE exams.

Students who have been selected to take part in this programme will be shown how to use it by their class teacher. Students will be provided with their individual login details and then initially assigned to the courses that we believe will help to improve their progress in Maths. TUTOR will be used in some specific Maths lessons at school but can also be accessed remotely from home at any time.

In addition, parents/guardians can also register for an account to view your child's progress. To do this, choose 'Parent' on the sign-up page (tutor.completemaths.com/register) and follow the instructions provided. You can then link your account to your child's account by using their unique token (this will have been given to them by their Maths teacher).
