This is a great opportunity for our students to experience some of the challenges and rigours of the world of work.

Finally, I must give a shout out to the students I spoke to in the library this week who were busy designing and working on their own board games. It was really brilliant to see the interest, engagement and imagination they were bringing to the work and I look forward to seeing the finished products!
